

Investors note several problems in Latvia that hamper investments

RIGA, Nov 13 (LETA) - The current and prospective investors in Latvia have pointed to several significant problems that hamper investments in Latvia, as the Foreign Investors Council in Latvia Executive Director Girts Greiskalns told LETA.

Foreign investors are concerned about availability of labor, the quality of education, employees' skills, and efficiency of the judicial system.

According to Greiskalns, increasing productivity would be best achieved by reducing taxes on labor.

The other taxes in Latvia are about the same as elsewhere in Europe, believes Greiskalns.
